Wedding planning is *no joke*! No matter how prepared you are, something unexpected *will* pop up. But don't stress—that's where your emergency kit comes in! Think of it as your wedding day insurance. After 13 years of photographing weddings, I've seen brides need these exact items. You don't have to pack *everything*, but trust me, you'll be glad you have the essentials!

Friendly Reminder: At the end of the day, you're marrying your best friend! If something small goes sideways, *let it go*—this day is about love, not perfection.

Brides, this kit is a game-changer, but it's also an *amazing* job for your maid of honor (if that's you, kudos for being the ultimate BFF)! Plus, it doubles as a honeymoon emergency kit—so you're covered beyond the wedding.

Touch-Up:

- Wedding day lip color
- face powder in a compact with mirror (for a shine that comes toward the end of the wedding)
- Eye drops (use a dry eye formula)
- Sunscreen (6 bottles so you can share them with your bride tribe)
- Deodorant
- brush/comb
- Bobby pins (in your hair color)

- Hair Spray (hair, static electricity and/or stocking runs)
- Handkerchief/tissues
- Tweezers
- Nail file
- Nail polish
- Q-tips
- Perfume / Body Spray
- Hand Lotion

Wellness:

- Pain reliever/
- Antacid / Stomach medicine/Bandaids
- Water bottle with straw (so you don't mess up your lipstick
- Mints (for queasiness and not gum as there's nothing pretty about a bride chewing gum)
- Snacks: <u>saltine crackers</u> (for queasiness), <u>almonds</u>, <u>protein</u>, <u>and/or energy bar</u>. For low blood sugar a piece of <u>hard candy</u>

Wardrobe Malfunction:

- Chalk (to cover any stain or mark on wedding dress)
- Mini sewing kit
- Safety pins
- <u>Lint roller</u> (for your and your groom)
- Super Glue (shoe or jewelry issues)
- Earring backs

Toiletries

- Extra contact lenses
- Floss
- Tampons

Miscellaneous:

- Charged cell phone
- <u>Cell phone charger</u> (this one plugs into the wall, and charges multiple types of phones with cords built-in).
- Cash
- ID
- Bug spray
- Antibacterial hand wipes (in the first aid kit also)
- Flats or flip flops
